What is OND?

*Opportunities For New Direction (OND), a division of OIC of Clark County, provides family reentry services to ex-offenders returning to the Springfield/Clark County community, to individuals with criminal backgrounds who have never been to prison, and to individuals working with the child support enforcement agency to satisfy child support arrearages. Job readiness training, peer mentoring, computer skills training and job placement are all services offered by *Opportunities For New Direction*.*

How does this program work?

Participants are enrolled in an intense programming that meets Monday-Thursday.

Participants are responsible for conducting independent job searches while they are enrolled in the program.



Who can Opportunities for New Direction help?

- Individuals with a past criminal background
- Individuals referred by child support agencies
- Individuals whose probation or parole officers have made it part of their community control to attend our *Opportunities For New Direction* program
- Individuals referred by local Judges as part of their sentencing
- Individuals who feel they need our assistance
