Mission

All agencies collaborate in working towards the goal of reducing recidivism in Stark County by identifying and filling service gaps for returning offenders and their families.

The United Way's 211 will serve as the central reference point for all agencies providing services for returning offenders and their families. It functions as an information and referral resource tool for returning offenders and their families who need additional access to community resources

- A. To provide a catalyst to break the cycle of crime by strengthening community participation and facilitating cooperative service delivery.
- B. To provide an organizational framework to support the reentry efforts of Stark County.
- C. To provide a mechanism for coordinating funding efforts related to reentry in Stark County.
- D. To provide a database outlining key reentry issues related to Stark County.
- E. To support collaboration and partnerships that strengthen the capacity of Stark County to provide quality programs and services that are culturally competent and responsive to the needs of returning offenders and their families based upon funding at the time services are needed.
- F. To increase community awareness of reentry needs and develop visibility for the mission.


